We will keep the tools on our site for up to 3 months and review pricing every 2-3 weeks on items that remain unsold (typically we would expect most tools to sell within 2-6 weeks of launch).

Our fees

20% plus VAT commission fee on the sale price realised.

Collection of items - we can collect by courier. You are responsible for packing the tools so there is no damage in transit. Collection fee is dependent on location and number of parcels. Please allow for £10 plus VAT for each parcel as a guide (parcel not to exceed 25kgs) but an exact figure can be quoted. Any return of items is charged at £10 plus VAT per parcel.

Terms

We retain the right to refuse items should defects adversely affect the tools function (wonky saw blades, pitted plane soles, incorrect fittings etc).

We will make payment to you once all items are sold and this will be made by bank transfer unless otherwise agreed.
